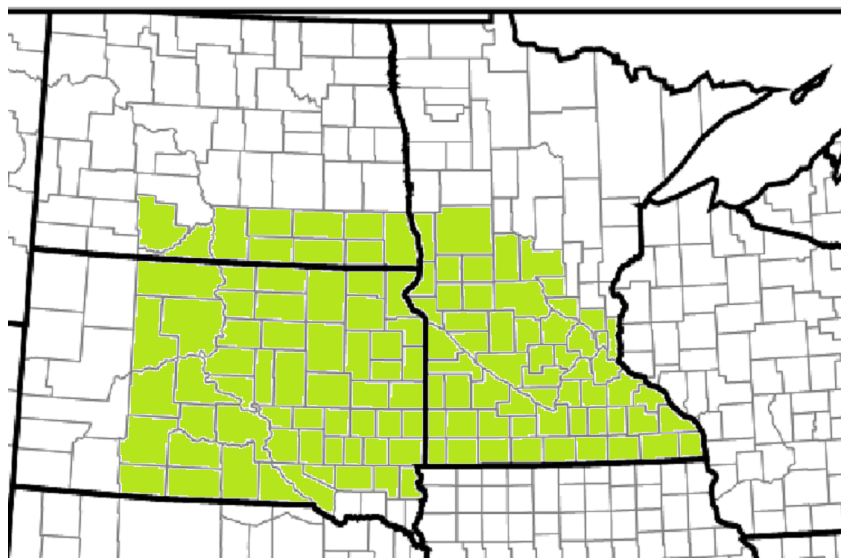


### Management Guidelines
